Maple Class have had a fantastic start to this academic year! They have settled really well into school life. They have made new friendships and are enjoying exploring their new learning environment.

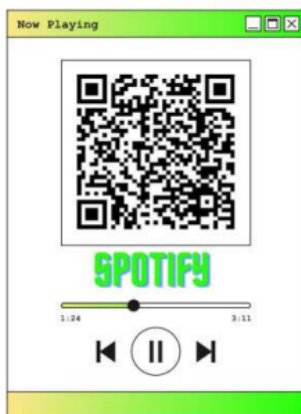
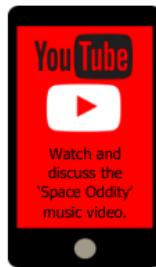

DAVID BOWIE



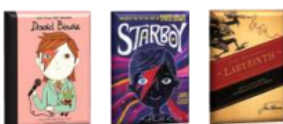
