## French Vision Statement

We aim for all learners to:

Develop resilience in language learning as well as enjoyment of it through a challenging scheme of work. Acquire language learning strategies for memorisation and retrieval as well as for listening, reading and understanding. Develop the skill of how to use a bi-lingual dictionary to decode unfamiliar language. Be able to manipulate language to speak or write sentences creatively using prior knowledge of grammar and key features; with and without a dictionary.



Have a sound understanding of the key sounds of the French language and their corresponding graphemes and be able to apply this knowledge when speaking, listening and reading aloud. Recognise some of the language patterns of French and how these differ or are similar to English. Appreciate and be able to copy the sound of the language at text level through songs, stories and rhymes. Demonstrate **excellent** progress in learning French and work towards or meet the targets of the KS2 Programme of Study for Languages. To have opportunities to **explore** cultural differences and similarities. We believe that learning a modern foreign language helps all pupils develop their interests and curiosity in the similarities and differences between themselves and others and enables them to value, not only their own culture and beliefs but those of others in different communities around the world (**equity**).
